Chris Evert

Evert, one of the most celebrated and beloved tennis players of her time, holds 157 singles titles and was ranked #1 in the world for seven straight years. An inductee into the International Tennis Hall of Fame, she was the first player to win 1,000 singles matches, going on to win 1,309 matches and 18 Grand Slam titles during her career. Today Evert makes her home in Palm Beach County and juggles her duties as a working mom along with running the annual Chris Evert Pro-Celebrity Tennis Classic, an event that has helped to raise over \$15.4 million in an ongoing campaign against drug abuse and child neglect in Florida.



Dottie Pepper

Dottie Pepper, a former LPGA great known for her quick wit and vibrant personality, currently serves as golf commentator for NBC Sports and The Golf Channel. Pepper joined the LPGA Tour in 1988 and won seventeen official events on the Tour, including two major championships: the 1992 and 1999 Kraft Nabisco Championships. Her 19-under-par finish in the 1999 victory still stands as the lowest score in relation to par in a major championship. She topped the money list in 1992 and finished in the top ten in ten of eleven seasons between 1991 and 2001. Pepper also played for the United States in the Solheim Cup six times. Pepper also makes her home in Palm Beach County and will serve as part of the NBC on-air broadcast team during the ADT Championship this week.
